### STRUCTURE OF PRODUCT TRANSACTION HISTORY

#### **INTRODUCTION**

This document describes the structure of an **XML** file containing the history of product transactions, which may be accepted by the customer service panel.

#### **DESCRIPTION OF FORM FIELDS**

FIELD	TYPE	DESCRIPTION	EXAMPLE
product	String(20)	Unique product identifier	P45678
transaction	String(20)	Identifier of the transaction containing the given product	621887
quantity	Integer	The number of pieces of a given product purchased during the transaction	4
price	Float	Price per piece of the purchased product	48.90
user	String(20)	The identifier of the user making the transaction. In the case of its absence, the field should be left blank	user13
timestamp	Timestamp	Date of the transaction in format yyyy-MM-dd or yyyy-MM-dd hh:mm:ss	2011-10-19

#### **COMMENTS**

- 1. Use a dot (not a comma) as a decimal separator.
- 2. Single information must indicate a single product ID. We do not accept files in which single information indicates a single transaction containing several products.
- 3. The ID of the products transferred in the transaction history file must match the ID of the products transferred to the catalogue.
